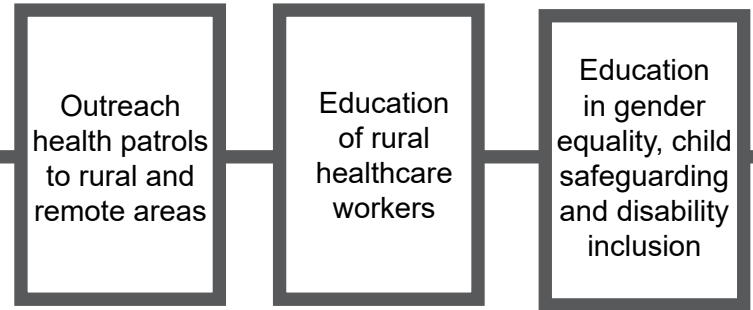
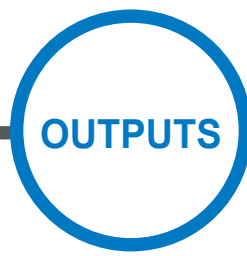
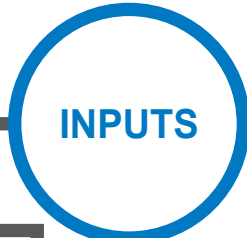


ADI THEORY OF CHANGE
